Battery Information

- The battery pack is not fully charged when purchased, please charge before the first usage.
- Do not short circuit the battery to avoid damaging the
- battery, generating heat and causing a fire. • Do not place the battery at a high temperature area or
- throw it into a fire to avoid an explosion. If the battery is not used for a while, discharge it and
- store it in dry, dark and cool place. Stop using the battery and cradle when it is damaged or
- significantly aged. Return the used batteries to the supplier or to the
- designated collection point, do not dispose indiscriminately.

If the battery is damaged, avoid touching the contents If it gets contaminated with the skin, rinse it with plenty of water. If necessary, ask for medical advice.

Basic Operation

Power On and Power Off

Press and hold the knob button for 3 seconds until power ON. To power OFF, press and hold the button, a window will pop up on the display, choose "Power OFF" and press MENU key to power OFF the radio.

Display Off / On

If the screen is lit up, short press the knob button to enter the off-screen state otherwise the radio display will automatically switch off after a period of inactivity. Short press the knob to wake up the display.

Home Page

The radio will load on the platform and enter the Home page after power on. Press the Up and Down key to enter Group, Settings, Account or Single call interface.

Status Bar

The status bar displays battery capacity, time, SIM card, registered network status information, etc.

Push-To-Talk function

After the start-up, the radio will automatically enter the default waiting group.

Single Call

On the home page, select Single Call to enter the Single call menu. On the single call mode screen, select a person to call and press the PTT key to initiate a call.

Group Call

On the home page, select Groups to enter the group menu, select a group in the group list, and press the PTT key to initiate a call. The group becomes an intercom waiting group, and does not receive intercom messages from other groups including the default group.

Group change

Short pressing the side button 1 to change to the desired group and there will be a voice announcement on the Group name. At the same time, the group becomes a Current group - Press PTT to start talking.

Account Setting

On the home page, press Navigation key to enter the Account setting menu, press Menu key to check and setup "Account, Area, Voice broadcast, Bright screen when receiving, Bright screen when calling, Power saving, 8K coding, Adaptive decoding, Style, Start call prompt, End call prompt, Only upload satellite positioning, Version."

Settings

On the home page, long press Side key 2 to enter the Settings. Press and hold down the up and down button of the navigation button to set or view "Network Settings, ocation. Startup sound. Phone. Factory settings restoration, Contacts, Call history, and Device status.

WLAN Connect (Optional)

1. Under the "Settings", press the UP/DOWN key to choose WLAN, press Menu key to confirm and enter the WLAN mode, now you can setup to connect the WLAN. 2. Under the WLAN, press OK button to turn ON or turn Off the WLAN. And you can see the "Connected WLANs/

Available WLANs/saved WLANs".

3. Press the UP/DOWN button to choose the WLAN you wanted, input the correct password and press Menu key to confirm and connect.

Set up the Bluetooth Connection (Optional)

- 1. Under "Settings", press OK button and press UP/ DOWN button to choose BT, and then press OK to enter BT settings;
- 2. Under BT, press OK button to turn on the BT and your
- radio will show the BT available list within the range. 3. Press UP/DOWN button to choose the device you want
- to connect, press OK to connect; Paired Device-Bluetooth list: Devices which already
- been paired previously or currently paired. Long press OK to delete the Paired device.
- Available Device-Bluetooth list: Device/s available for pairing in the surrounding vicinity.
- 4. If you switched on "Discoverable", other devices may be able to search your Bluetooth.
- 5. When entering Bluetooth password, press OK to confirm and enter the keyboard, you could long press the side key 2 to switch the Input.

PoC Service

Push-to-talk over Cellular (PoC) provides direct one-to-one and one-to-many voice communication services over the cellular network. After the start-up, the radio will automatically enter the default waiting group.

Charger Information

- To improve charging efficiency and ensure charging safety, please use 100-240V AC.
- Do not short-circuit the charger, or it would cause
- electric shock, smog, and damage to the charger. Do not use the charger when the cable is damaged, or
- it may cause fire and electric shock.
- Please clean the dust accumulated on the power outlet over time.
- Do not disassemble or modify the charger. It may cause electric shock, file or damage to the charger.
- Do not use the charger in places with high temperatures or it may cause electric shock, fire or damage to the charger.
- Do not touch the charger, battery, or power outlet with wet hands, or it would cause electric shock.
- Do not place heavy objects on the power cable, or attempt to modify the power cable, otherwise, it may cause electric shock or fire.

Charging the Battery

Charge the battery with the specified charger and charge the battery as follows:


- 1. Insert the DC plug of the switching power supply into charger pod, and insert the switching power supply into the AC power output socket, you will see the green light
- 2.Put the battery or the radio into the socket, you will see the red light on.
- 3.When the LED turns green, it means fully charged. Please remove the power plug and from the power outlet.

Start a call

When the screen is on, press the side key1, the radio will announce the current group and enters the group list. Press Up key or Down key to select the previous group or the next group, press OK key to enter the member list, press Up or down key to search for members in the group, and press OK to select or cancel members. If a member has been selected at this time, press PTT key to enter a temporary group call, then press the PTT key to talk with the member, after the intercom, press Back key to enter the original group waiting.

Emergency Alarm (SOS)

Long press the side key 1 to send SOS to the dispatching console and online members.

Note: This function would be invalid if the Dispatch Console did not register an alarm number to the radio ID.

Safety Precautions

When using the radios, please hold the Device in a correct position as if using a lined telephone. Talk through the microphone and make sure the Device is at an appropriate distance away from your body. Some people may be prone to seizures or dizziness under flashing lights (Such as watching TV). If you have a similar medical history of illness, consult your doctor before using the flash function. Keep the device away from children.

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Care should be taken when using radio next to certain medical devices such as pacemakers. Keep a distance of at least 20cm between the radio and these medical devices; do not put the radio in your chest pocket. Hold BBGR to the ear at the opposite side of the body where the pacemaker is implanted to reduce potential interference. If necessary, please turn off the radio. If these disturbances occur, contact the hearing aid manufacture for a solution. If you have any other medical equipment (such as implanted cochlea), consult with the manufacturer to ensure that these devices can shield the surrounding RF signals.
